St. Stanislaus Church Parish Council Minutes March 19, 2024

Monsignor David Cox called the meeting to order and led the council with an opening prayer.

Council Members Present: Pat Mingucci, Eric Jaegers, Lisa Ashcraft, Tim Hagenhoff, Betty Kever, Emily Mantle, Pam Stonner, and Sue Rackers

Minutes: The minutes from January 16, 2024, were approved by all.

Knights of Columbus Property: The Knights of Columbus approached the parish about purchasing a property which adjoins parish property. As research around the purchase continues, it was determined the roof likely needs to be replaced. The Diocese has been contacted. The Properties Director will review the property and provide appropriate contracts for the purchase. Finance Council and Parish Council have agreed to proceed with the purchase of the property.

Anointing of the Sick Mass: Mass will be held on Wednesday, March 27th at 8:00 a.m. Anointing of the sick is offered for elderly, infirmed, or those suffering from chronic or life-threatening illnesses. St. Stanislaus students are hosting the event, will sing at the mass, and will host a brunch in the school after mass. Signups are encouraged to help estimate the number of participants.

Seven Churches Pilgrimage: Monsignor reminded the council of the visits to seven churches following mass on Holy Thursday. This pilgrimage provides an opportunity to visit the alters of each church and to meditate on the seven stations which occurred following the Last Supper on Holy Thursday. Churches participating are St. Peter (Jefferson City), St. Joseph Cathedral, Immaculate Conception (Jefferson City), St. Martin, St. Andrew, St. Francis Xavier, and St. Stanislaus.

Novena of the Divine Mercy Chaplet: The parish will participate in a Divine Mercy Novena at noon on Good Friday and at 8:30 a.m. on Holy Saturday. The Novena will continue as a parish on April 1st – 7th (completing after 10:30 a.m. mass).
