Enrollment Deadline
February 3, 2025

After application is accepted, complete enrollment packet in FACTS. Enrollment includes supplementary documentation (i.e., vaccination records, custodial agreements), tuition payment plan selection, and payment of \$200 first-time enrollment fee. Students enrolled after February 3 will be assessed a \$50 late fee.



Course Registration Deadline
February 21, 2025

Application/enrollment must be completed to register for courses. Submit completed course selection form to the Counseling Department. Eighth-grade students at diocesan partner schools will receive course selection information starting in January.
