Children's Prayer Bags

Children's Prayer Bags are now located in a drawer in the back of church for young children to use during weekend masses. If you feel your child would benefit please take one at the beginning of mass then sanitize (wipes enclosed in the bag) before returning at the end of mass. The bags are labeled by age and with a letter as there are several varieties of bags for each age. The activities will be changed periodically. We hope this helps the children grow in their faith and provide them with some hands on learning during mass.

Breaking the Silence of Abuse

As a diocese, we are committed to breaking the silence of abuse. When someone is reporting abuse, we must acknowledge their pain and how difficult it is to talk about it.
