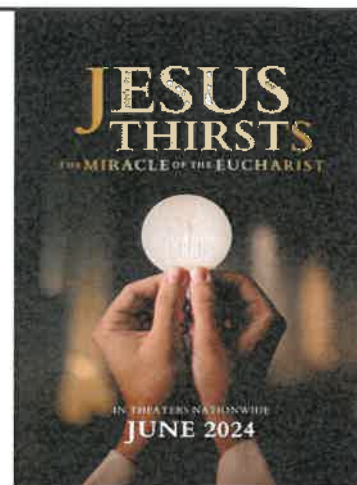

- July 3 - From Ss. Peter & Paul, Boonville to New Franklin (3.6 miles)
From the outskirts of Columbia to St. Thomas More Newman Center, along the MKT trail (4.7 miles)
From the outskirts of Jefferson City to our Cathedral of St. Joseph (4 miles)
- July 5 - From our Cathedral of St. Joseph to the Proto-Cathedral of St. Peter (2 miles)

Jeremiah Bruemmer received a \$2,000 MFA Foundation Scholarship, which helps students pursue studies and develop careers that enhance the future of rural America.

Jada Markway received the Joseph Mayer Memorial Scholarship and a \$500 scholarship from the Pink Star Foundation, whose mission is to provide assistance for the elderly, those with disabilities and the homeless community in the greater Jefferson City area.

Kearra Steinlage received the Hawthorn Bank Award, given to a boy and girl in each class who have the highest academic achievement.

Madison Verslues received the following awards:

- The John Baptiste De La Salle Service Award for contributing 500 or more hours of service to our community during her high school years.
