Sunday Masses: There will be changes in what we are doing in keeping with restrictions that have been set by Bishop McKnight.

- All the faithful of the Diocese of Jefferson City, and those who are present in the territory of the Diocese, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation until 11 September 2020, provided that for days of precept after 1 July 2020 they do one of the following:
 - a. Participate in the Sunday or holy day of obligation Mass livestreamed from their parish church or chapel, the Cathedral, or the Vatican or Heart of the Nation website.
 - b. Prayerfully read and meditate on the readings of the Mass for the Sunday or holy day of obligation, and recite the rosary.
 - c. Prayerfully read and meditate on the readings of the Mass for the Sunday or holy day of obligation, and recite the Divine Mercy chaplet.
- The faithful are obliged to wear a mask (or other face covering) upon entering the church and during the celebration of Mass, except when seated in the pew and for the brief moment of receiving Holy Communion.
- Families are to maintain six-foot distancing between their family and other families or individuals throughout the celebration of Mass.
- There will be no collection of envelopes and no offertory procession, however there will be a basket in the front of Church and also in the back of Church for you to put your donation in. Thank you for your continued financial support.
