Sunday Masses:

- All the faithful of the Diocese of Jefferson City, and those who are present in the territory of the Diocese, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays / Holy Days of Obligation until 11 September 2020, provided that for days of precept after 1 July 2020 they do one of the following:
 - - a. Participate in the Sunday /holy day of obligation Mass livestreamed from their parish church/ chapel, the Cathedral, or the Vatican or Heart of the Nation website.
 - b. Prayerfully read and meditate on the readings of the Mass for the Sunday / holy day of obligation, and recite the Rosary or Divine Mercy chaplet.
- Families are to maintain six-foot distancing between their family and other families or individuals throughout the celebration of Mass.
- There will be no collection of envelopes and no offertory procession, however there will be a basket in the front of Church and also in the back of Church for you to put your donation in. Thank you for your continued financial support.
