We would like to call your attention to a new wall hanging that is mounted on the back wall of our Church between the opening to the stairwell and the Holy Water font. We have framed a board that was found under the altar stone of our old altar during the remodel. It's an inscription that was hand written by the Reverend F.W. Gerhold, pastor of St. Stanislaus in 1928. It reads:

"VISURI SALUTEM" (Welcome all who come)

Opening for Altar Stone , cut into meusa (table) August 21, 1928 by Rev F.W. Gerhold"

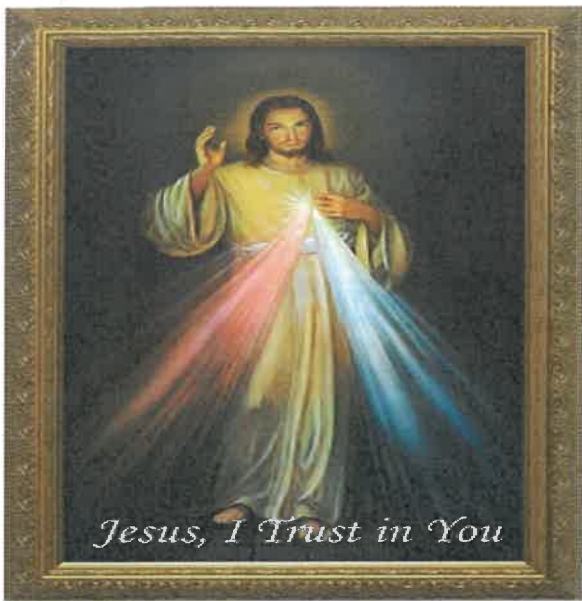

Is looking ahead for the upcoming school year and they are requesting the following items:

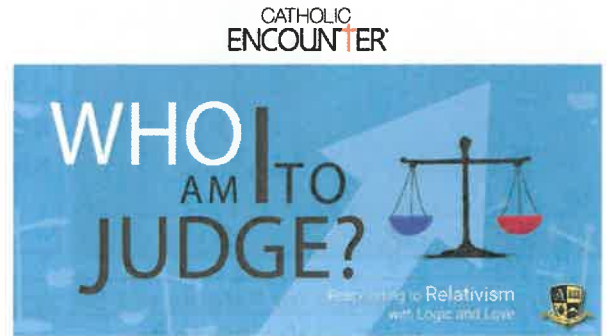
