## Knights of Columbus 5th Sunday

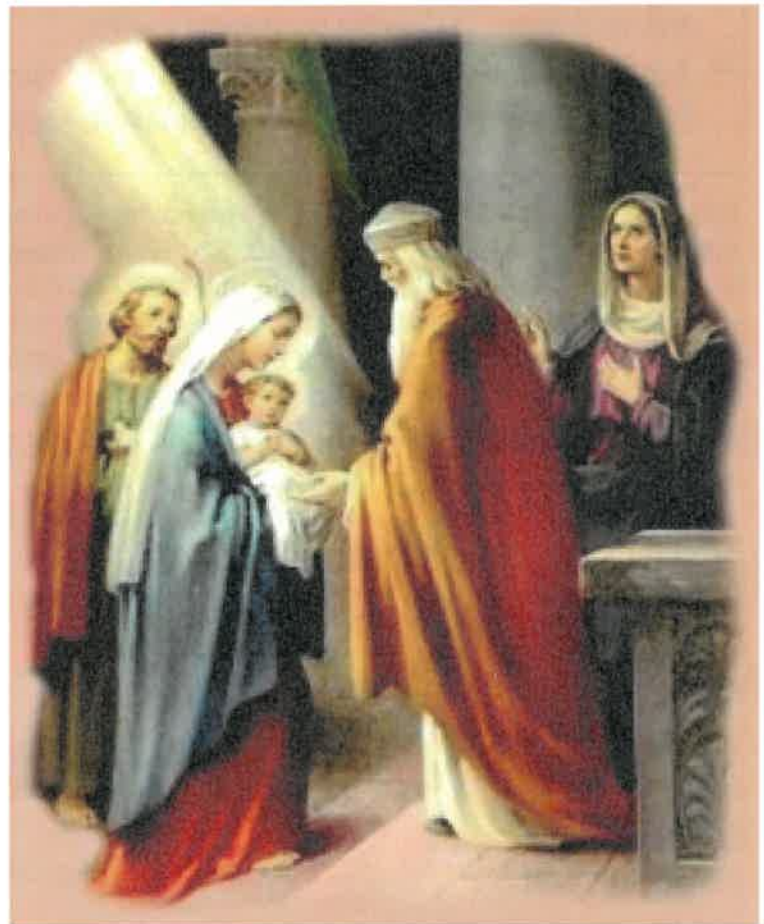
On Sunday, January 30th
