January 27, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Paula Wilbers and open with a prayer by Msgr. David Cox. Members present: Paula Wilbers, Diane Eggen, Leon Eichholz, Eric Lecuru and Kay Stockman.

Msgr. Cox provided a copy of the Balance Sheet of the Cemetery and Mausoleum Committee as of January 22, 2022. Msgr. Cox brought to our attention that four of the CDs were receiving very low interest rates and with investing them with the Diocese they could probably earn 4%. After a discussion it was decided to invest these with the Diocese.

Msgr. Cox stated that Dale Stockman had donated the lot south/left of the gravel road to the parish. Dale reserving seven burial plots along highway. The lot may need to be rezoned which the Buildings and Grounds Committee was checking into. He was certain if all the paper work had been completed at this time. The lot would need to have some fill, possibly finding some that could be donated.

Paula stated that the windows still need to be tinted to protect the floor from the sun. This project has been discussed several times in the past. It is something that we need to have done.

Leon Eichholz reported he was retiring from the position of overseeing the cemetery and mausoleum. Thanks Leon for your years of doing this. Don Kever has agreed to take over. Thanks Don

Jane Rackers donated a Veterans Memorial in memory of her husband, Robert J. Ahsens III. It will be located on the North of the mausoleum. The of the Veterans buried in the cemetery will be listed on it (there will be a side for each branch of service, Army, Navy, Air Force and Marines. It will be known as the "St. Stanislaus Veterans Memorial".

Two benches have been donated by Betty Kliethermes and family in memory of Harry Kliethermes to be placed by the Veterans Memorial.
