When I first arrived here, at the Mass of my installation as your pastor, Bishop McKnight stated in his remarks to the parish that we should make every effort to separate the parish offices and the rectory for the mental health and privacy of the priest.

After living in your rectory these past months, I can greatly appreciate this. Your parish office is a very busy place. This is a great thing, but I will greatly appreciate having a more peaceful, private home.

Just weeks after the Bishop's remarks the Markway property became available and the family offered it to our parish before putting it on the market. This seemed like an answer to prayer.
