Lenten Faith Step

We began the liturgical year of Lent on Ash Wednesday. Lent is a time of spiritual renewal, a type of "spiritual spring," It is also a term that identifies the season with the 40-day period of preparation before the celebration of Jesus' Passion, Death, and Resurrection. A time of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. A Faith Step will be shared as a suggestion to do during each week of Lent. Our Faith Step this week: Watch for those who especially need Jesus' love. Then ask Jesus to show you some unique way to make these and others feel special.
