We are participating in the Box of Joy program from Cross Catholic Outreach. We have participated the past five years with the PSR group and St. Stanislaus School. This service project is supported by St. Stanislaus / St. Margaret's Pro-Life Group and we are excited to bring this program back to our community. This program blesses children suffering from extreme poverty by sharing the joy of Christmas and planting seeds of hope through the Gospel. These boxes are delivered by Catholic missionaries in Guatemala, Haiti, Dominican Republic, Nicaragua, El Salvador, Grenada, and Honduras.



Box of Joy provides students an engaging opportunity to send boxes filled with toys, clothing, school supplies, a rosary and the Story of Jesus to children in developing countries.
