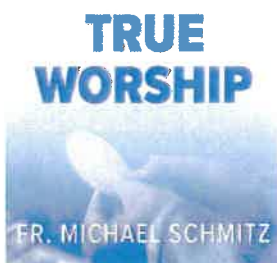
Blessed Duns Scotus
