12:00 noon - 1 p.m. – a respectful protest in the corridor outside the Governor's office (Room 216) in the State Capitol Building, Jefferson City
5 - 6 p.m. – vigil on sidewalk across from the MO Supreme Court Building on High Street, Jefferson City
