St. Stanislaus Church-Parish Council Minutes October 20, 2022

Dana Frese called the meeting to order. Monsignor David Cox led the council with an opening prayer.

Council Members Present: Dana Frese, Mary Markway, Lisa Ashcraft, Eric Jaegers and Pam Stonner. Absent: Lisa Patten, Pat Mingucci and Sue Rackers.

Minutes: The minutes from August 15, 2022 were approved by all.

Monsignor Cox: Parishioners have approached Monsignor to move the mass times on Saturday evening from 5:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Moving mass times to 4:00 p.m. will affect Weddings, rush wedding photography and Confession time. Changing mass time could cause disruption to other parishioners who are accustomed to the mass time at 5:30 p.m. There are 2 masses on Sunday in daylight hours. After great discussion about changing the mass times, all members of the parish council were in favor of keeping the mass time on Saturday evening at 5:30 p.m.

Financial Report: The parish council is still waiting to receive a copy of the 2023 Budget from the Financial committee. We hoped to have received it by the October meeting.

K of C Donation: There is a positive response for the status of Fund raising for the Knights of Columbus building. Monsignor asked the Knights if they would ever decide to sell any of their acquired land that the parish be notified first as the land is adjacent to the church. The K of C will reach out to its members to donate for the K of C building. The Finance Committee voted in favor of making a donation to the Knights of Columbus building. The Finance Committee advised the parish council that the monies are there. Lisa Ashcraft made a motion to make a donation for the Knights of Columbus building, Mary Markway second the motion, all were in favor, motion carried.

Fall Festival: Final numbers were not in on the Fall Festival. The Country Store made more than in past years. Hope to see the Fall Festival final results soon.

Monsignor said that on November 2nd after mass there will be a procession to the cemetery to Bless the Stations of the Cross between the Rectory and the Cemetery.

On Veterans Day, November 11th, after mass there will be a procession to the cemetery to bless the Veterans Memorial.

Masses for All Saints Day, Nov 1st, will be held at 8:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. at St. Stanislaus and at 7:00 p.m. at St. Margaret's.

Immaculate Conception, December 8th, masses will be held on the eve (Nov 7th) at 6:30 p.m., 8:00 a.m. at St. Stanislaus and 6:30 p.m. at St. Margaret's.

Christmas Masses: St. Stanislaus Mass schedule: 5:30 p.m. Christmas Eve, Mid-Night Mass at Mid-Night Christmas Eve, and at 7:30 a.m. St. Margaret's Mass schedule will be 7:00 p.m. Christmas Eve and 9:00 a.m. Christmas morning.

New Years Day: Mass times for New Year's Eve and Day will be at the normal mass times.

Penance Service will be held from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. with music playing. The date for Penance Service is forthcoming.

School: A new key system for school will be installed in the next couple of weeks by the Entertainer.

4th and 5th Grade Retreat "Saints Among Us" was held on October 19th. Grant Boessen and Cole Morehead, seniors at Helias and graduates of St. Stanislaus talked about their favorite saint along with Coach Rockers from Helias.

Parent, Teacher conferences are October 20th.

Parish: RCIA began Monday, we have 7 adults to join the church at Easter.

PSR students had scripture rosary Wednesday, October 19th in church with their parents.

Confirmation: The tentative date for Confirmation is Tuesday, March 7th, at 6:30 p.m. with the bishop. With the PSR 7th grade, St. Stanislaus and St. Margaret's 7th grade there will be 28 candidates to be confirmed.

8 Week Book Club: "Jesus Calling" will have its class next Tuesday. We have 11 participants. An awesome group of ladies, especially the younger 40 to 45 age group.

Feast Day of St. Stanislaus and the 140 Year Anniversary Celebration: Sign up list are located at the back of church and at Perpetual Adoration for the carry in dinner at St. Stanislaus after the 10:30 mass.

Magnificat Companion for Advent will be available before the first Sunday of Advent.

"**Holy Moments**" by Matthew Kelly will be distributed to the parish at all masses for Christmas. The books were donated by a generous parishioner.

Maintenance items: The tree between the church and school has broken limbs that are a safety concern. The parish will get estimates for Korte to take care of the tree..

Bids are being taken for a roof leak at the entrance way of church. The leak needs repair.

Parish Directory: Jayme Baumgartner Wilbers will partner with Brown Printing to make a new parish directory. The time frame will be January through March and information is forthcoming.

Dana mentioned that he attended a meeting at the Chancery. St. Stanislaus Church is in the "Holy See" deanery group along with St. Joseph Cathedral, St. Peter's, Immaculate Conception, St. Martins, St. Margaret's, St. Andrews, St. Thomas, Meta and **2 other parishes**. Priest have many task and these groups are to collaborate and come up with ideas in how we can create efficiencies for the priest and shaping the future together with new and stronger relationships.

Parish Stewardship: Dana and Gary Wilbers will meet to start organizing for the small group stewardship commitments for our parish. The CSA will no longer be and for the future the families are to tithe 8% to the parish and 1% to the diocese. More information to come on this.

The next scheduled meeting is set for January 17, 2023 in the Parish Center starting at 6:30 p.m. Future meetings for 2023 are:

March 21, 2023, May 16, 2023, August 15, 2023, and October 17, 2023. The closing prayer was led by Monsignor Cox. The meeting was adjourned.
