Council Members Present: Dana Frese, Mary Markway, Lisa Ashcraft, Eric Jaegers, Lisa Patten, Pat Mingucci and Sue Rackers and Pam Stonner.

Minutes: The minutes from October 20, 2022 were approved by all.

Financial Report: Monsignor shared and discussed the July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 Financial Report with the council.

School: Catholic Schools week starts Sunday, January 29 at 10:30 Mass with the children participating in the roles of the Mass. Catholic Schools' week will end on Friday, February 3rd, with each day of Catholic Schools week having a theme.

Special Parish Council Meeting: The Council will meet with Gary Wilbers on February 14th, at the Parish Center at 6:30 p.m. This meeting will address Stewardship Groups. Gary will address the parishioners at mass on February 4th and 5th.

Second Funeral Group: A second group to help with funeral dinners has been formed. This seems to be working well.
