The following have been the topics covered. We would like to encourage everyone to prayerfully consider the questions below as consider the area of stewardship during this Lenten reflection.

Week 1

This week's session, which reflected on the healing of the blind man Bartimaeus, includes this passage:

"We need to see life clearly, unimpeded by the distractions that so often block our view. We need vision—to see with eyes of wonder and awe, to perceive Jesus, our savior and brother, who walks with us, while seeing all we need to do in order to share Christ's love in the world.

In what ways do you need clearer vision of Jesus and his place in your life? What would help you achieve that goal?

Week 2

This week's session, which reflects on the fact that we are made in the image of God, includes this passage: "A spirituality of stewardship invites us to recognize that God calls all of creation good. We who are created in God's image are called to reflect this goodness in the world." How do you reflect God's goodness in the world around you? What else could you do?
