"It's gonna be May!" How is it possible that it is May, and we have only a few weeks of school left? This school year has definitely flown by. It's amazing how much the kids have grown spiritually, physically, and academically.

**Home and School:** Thank you to everyone who came out to our last Home and School meeting on Monday! We are so blessed to have an incredible partnership with our Home and School Association and look forward to their continued support of our school.

**Pizza Haus:** Thank you to all the parents and parishioners who purchased half-baked pizzas from Pizza Haus in April! You helped out St. Stanislaus's Home and School as well as the business of Pizza Haus with this optional fundraiser. The pizzas looked pretty tasty!

**Field Trips:** Our 4th and 5th graders sang the National Anthem at a Springfield Cardinals game last week and enjoyed watching the Cardinals take home a win. The 6th graders attended Vocation Day in Columbia with surrounding schools from the Diocese where they shared in the Eucharist with Bishop McKnight and had small group breakout sessions on marriage, priesthood, and religious life. This is done to make sure everyone who could be on campus is a safe adult, but also to make sure all adults who may be involved with the school are trained to identify when a child might be at risk. We want to make sure we do our best to keep our children safe. Information will be sent out in the near future of how to get this completed by our parents and guardians and is super easy to complete.
