2025 Shroud of Turin Conference & Symposium

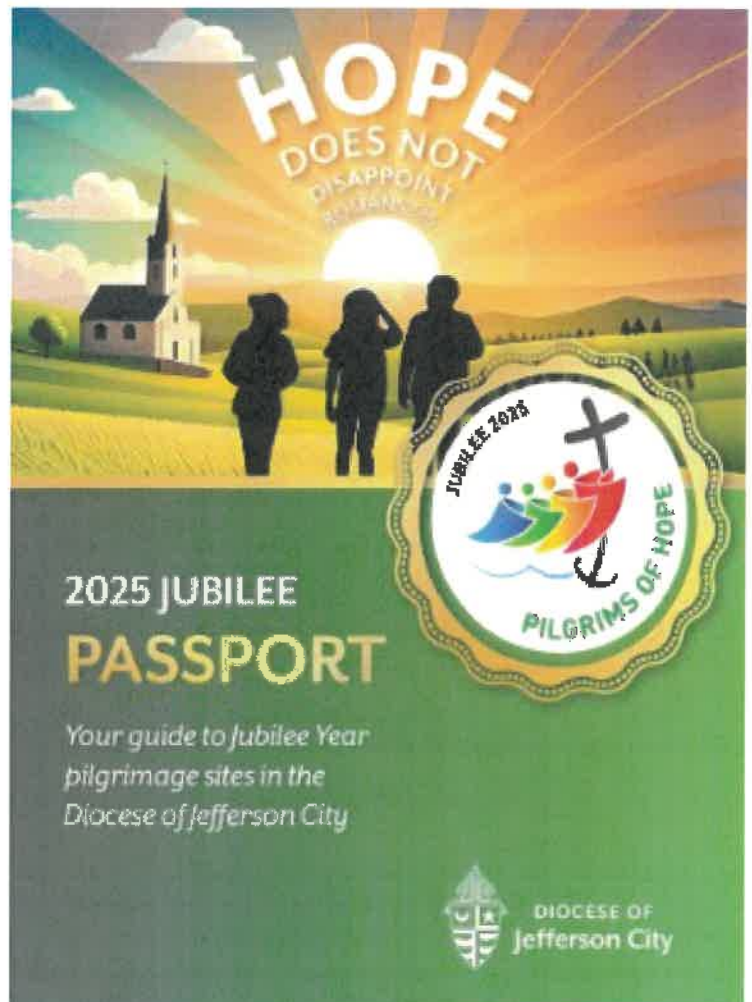
