

# St. Stanislaus Cemetery update

A new concrete driveway was poured between section 2 and section 3 of the cemetery.

The new driveway was open before Easter Sunday. Unfortunately, due to unknown sources, two days after being open, property damage took place to both sides of the newly seeded/straw by the new driveway. Three separate areas of the driveway were damaged by drivers who tore up the newly sewn grass areas causing costly damage to the cemetery grounds. Due to this unfortunate incident taking place, the new driveway between section 2 & 3 is closed until further notice. The grounds will need to be repaired once the ground is dry and the damage area is fixed.

We are asking drivers to park down by the mausoleum, drive up the middle driveway and back out, or park at the front of the cemetery off of Route W by the fence/gate. All three driveways are for single vehicles only.

Please be mindful when meeting a vehicle in the driveways to back up safely or use another driveway that is open. Do not block the driveway and make sure to stay on the driveway. Please be respectful and mindful of those visiting gravesites.

## New cemetery policy for St Stanislaus Cemetery - 4/2025

From April 1 to October 31 of each year, all objects deemed by management to hinder any ground maintenance shall be removed. We reserve the right to remove any objects that are not allowed.

Spring clean-up in April (normally held the week before Easter). Fall clean-up is held in October (normally the week before Fall Supper.) Notices of the clean-up dates are published in the church bulletin 3 weeks prior to scheduled date.

# The following rules will be enforced:

All artificial flowers must be in vases. Saddles on top of the monument will be allowed.

Temporary memorial flowers must be put inside vases on the monument.

Because of the wind, the flowers/saddles blow off and around the cemetery. We suggest labeling any flowers with your name and number on the back side of the flowers if you would like to have them returned.

No Glass objects of any kind.

No Shepard hooks/flags unless part of the monument base or in the vases securely.

No stones/figurines unless part of the monument base. These tend to blow over and get damaged or broken.

No planted flowers/shrubs/trees of any kind shall be permitted in the ground around the monument or in planters.

NO pets are allowed on cemetery grounds. (It has been reported that dogs have been doing their business on gravesites and driveways. The owner of the dog did not dispose of the dog droppings as they should have. This is disrespectful to burial sites and cemetery property. For this reason, no pets are allowed on the premises.)

This is a tobacco and smoke free cemetery property.

We appreciate your cooperation in following these rules and keeping our cemetery grounds looking nice.
