Pickleball Enthusiasts

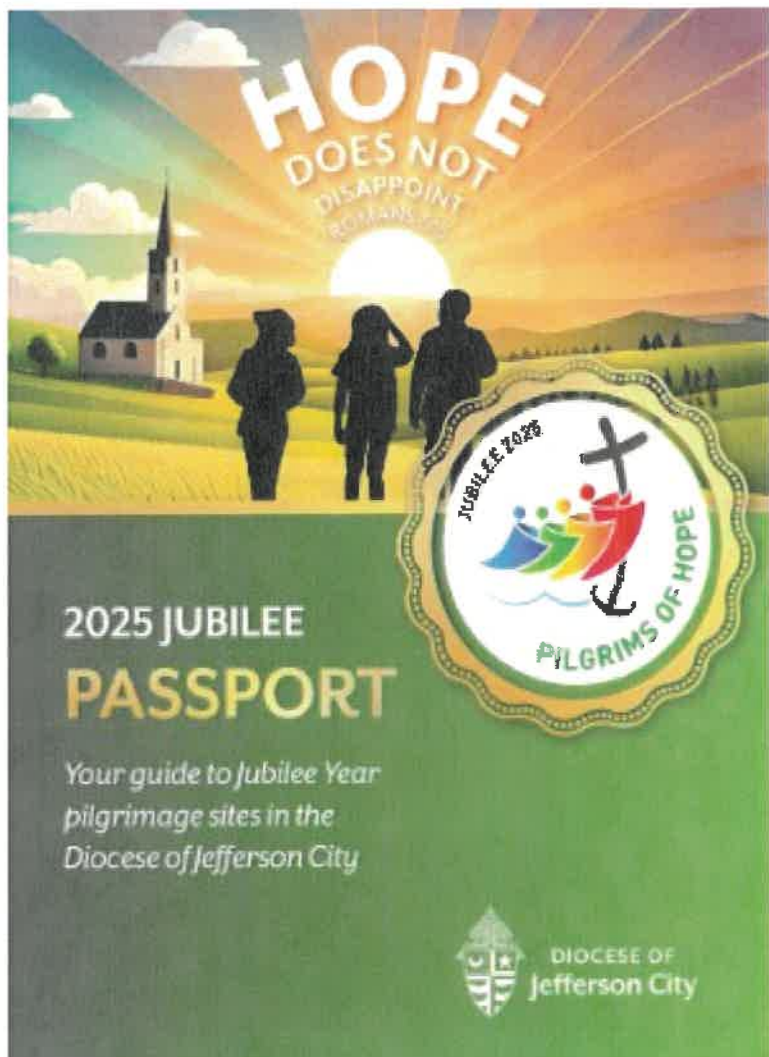
