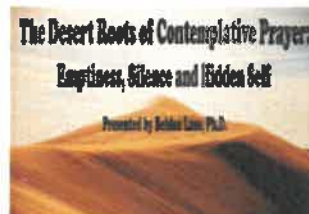
### **Help Us Celebrate St. Stanislaus Feast Day!**
