**CONFIRMATION CANDIDATES:** Please keep our 7th graders in your prayers as they prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation.


**2ND GRADERS:** Please keep our 2nd graders in your prayers as they prepare for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
