

Dear Parishioners,

We would like to begin by expressing our sincere gratitude to everyone who has increased your giving over the past six months. Your generosity, along with our continued efforts to carefully manage and control expenses, has made a meaningful difference. Because of your response, we have been able to reduce our operating deficit, and we are truly thankful.

We also recognize how important communication is during times like these. Moving forward, we are committed to providing quarterly updates and regular correspondence so that everyone has a clearer understanding of our financial situation and the progress being made. Transparency helps us move forward together.

While the parish supports the school budget as a whole, one area that we can use assistance is the School Lunch Program. Students pay \$4.00 per meal, but the actual cost which includes cooks' salaries, increased food costs, and decreased federal subsidies is approximately \$5.75 - \$6.35 which leaves a deficit of approximately \$50,000-\$60,000 a year. We want to share that all school families are current in paying their monthly lunch fees, our fees are consistent with other parochial schools, and there is very little waste within the program. Even so, the rising costs continue to create a gap.

If anyone feels called to make a specific donation to support the lunch program, we would be deeply grateful. Please simply mark "Lunch Program" on your envelope or check, and place it in the offertory basket or mail it to the parish center.

Thank you again for your continued prayers, generosity, and support of our parish and school during the 2025-2026 school year.
