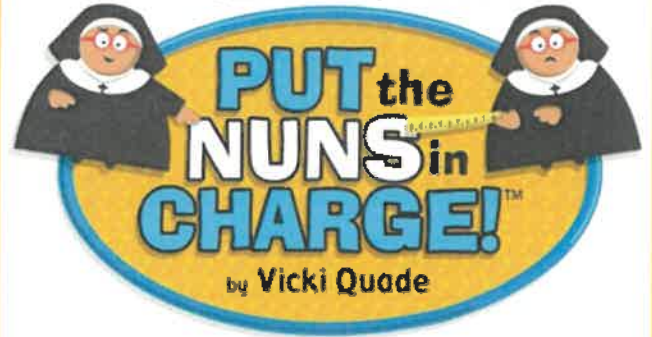
Breaking the Silence of Abuse

False allegations are very rare. Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate. 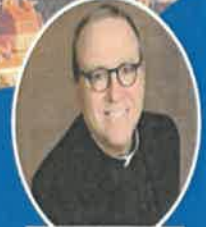
