**St. Stanislaus Church-Parish Council
Minutes May 19, 2026**

Monsignor Cox called the meeting to order with an opening prayer.

Council Members Present: Tim Hagenhoff, Betty Kever, Emily Bailey, Emily Mantle, Josh Barbour, Justin Buschjost, Missy Wilbers, Kristen Pringer, Pam Stonner, and Amy Steinman.

Guests: Mrs. Tina Forbis, Principal and Gary Wilbers

Parish Database: Gary Wilbers informed the Council of several options for a new parish database that would allow more and better electronic features for both the parish staff and parishioners to communicate. The system has the ability for text, email, online giving, calendar of events/holy days, find and request substitutes for mass, etc. Gary and Dana Wilbers are working to finalize which system is the best and then plan to get it implemented.

Grounds Report: Betty Kever reported the following items will be repaired or adjusted during the summer months:

- Concrete repair of east parking lot, sidewalk, and steps;
- Restriping of parking lot, front of church, and north side of school;
- Additional gravel for added parking behind Parish Center;
- Caulking of windows on north side of school;
- Repair meeting room ceiling in Parish Center;
- Repair work on Frank property;
- Power washing of buildings and concrete.

School Report: Tina Forbis reported the following:

- Current number of students enrolled for the 2026-2027 school year is 188;
- The school is looking for a Music teacher;
- The first day of school will be August 13, 2026;
- The Technology Dinner and Auction fundraiser is being planned for April 3, 2027.

Monsignor Cox Report:

- A celebration of the 40th Anniversary of the Eucharistic Adoration will be on October 25, 2026.

Parish Council Elections: Tim Hagenhoff, Pam Stonner, and Betty Kever will be going off the council. Elections are planned for July 11 and 12, 2026. The council will be looking for three new candidates to serve.

Crosswalk - Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB): The Council continues to research the installation of an RRFB at one of the crosswalks in front of the parish property on Route W. Council members will coordinate with MoDOT on placement. A contractor will be hired to install the devices and MoDOT will maintain after installation.

The next Parish Council meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 18th at 6:30 p.m., in the Parish Center.

Monsignor Cox led the parish council with a closing prayer. The meeting was adjourned.
